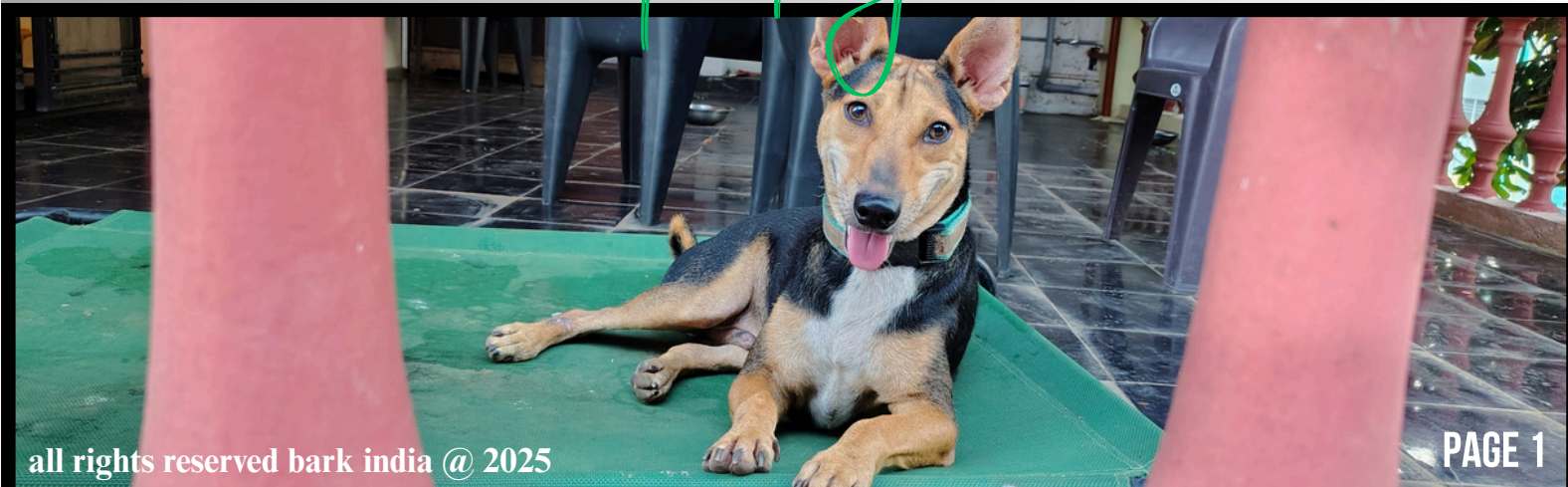

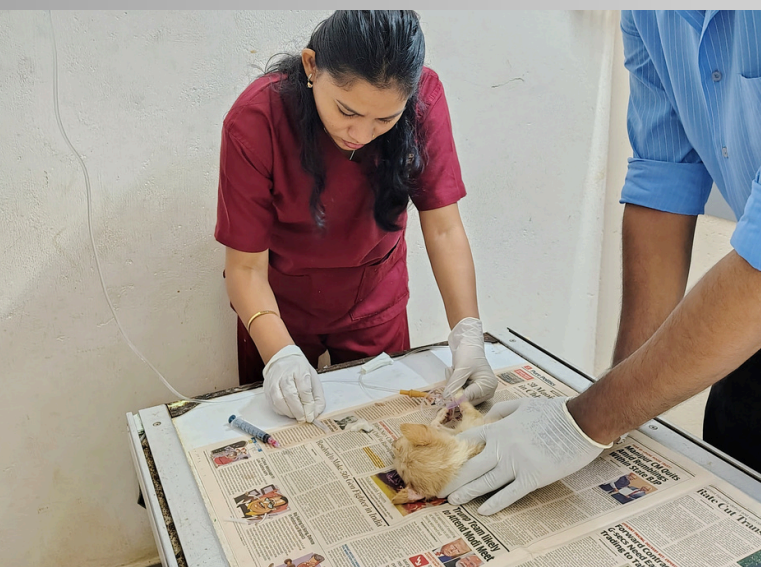

last month we rescued and treated 80 animals in distress. These included cases of road accidents, severe wounds, abandonment, and other medical emergencies. Our dedicated rescue team acted swiftly to ensure each animal received immediate care, pain relief, and the chance to recover in a safe environment. Every rescue reflects our commitment to being a lifeline for the voiceless and vulnerable animals on our streets.

In the past month, Bark India Charitable Trust provided outpatient medical care to 104 animals. These included dogs and cats brought in by kind-hearted individuals and local residents who noticed animals in need of help. Our veterinary team worked tirelessly to diagnose, treat, and follow up on various conditions—from minor injuries and infections to skin issues and early-stage illnesses. Each outpatient visit represents not just a life treated, but also a step toward building a more compassionate community that actively looks out for our voiceless companions.



VETERINARY SURGERIES -34



Last month, 34 stray animals underwent surgeries at our clinic. From treating deep wounds and hematoma to performing fracture repairs, amputations and sterilizations, each procedure was done with care.



STRAY ANIMAL FEEDING - 350



This vital effort costs around ₹3,500 for street feeding and ₹1,500 per day for those in our care.

vaccinated 60 stray dogs, protecting them from life-threatening diseases such as rabies, distemper, and parvovirus.
